

Setting Up Sauce Labs and Bitbucket Pipelines

It's easy to launch your automated Selenium and Appium tests on Sauce Labs as part of your Bitbucket Pipelines build process.

Prerequisites

- A [Sauce Labs account](#)
- A [Bitbucket account](#)
- [Bitbucket Pipelines](#) installed on your Bitbucket account

Procedure

1. Configure your `bitbucket-pipelines.yml` file to run your tests using your test runner of choice.

2. In Bitbucket, click **Settings** in the left hand nav bar.
3. Under **Pipelines**, click **Environment Variables**.
4. Add your `SAUCE_USERNAME` and `SAUCE_ACCESS_KEY` as environment variables.

Finding Your Username and Access Key

You can find your Sauce Labs username and access key in the **User Profile > User Settings** section of your Sauce Labs dashboard. You should also check out [our topic on setting your username and access key as environment variables](#).

Now when you kick off a a build with Bitbucket Pipelines, your tests should run on Sauce Labs.
