

Setting Up Sauce Labs and Bitbucket Pipelines

It's easy to launch your automated Selenium and Appium tests on Sauce Labs as part of your Bitbucket Pipelines build process.

What You'll Need

- The USERNAME and ACCESSKEY [specific to your Sauce Labs account](#).

Prerequisites

- A [Sauce Labs account](#)
- A [Bitbucket account](#)
- [Bitbucket Pipelines](#) installed on your Bitbucket account

Procedure

1. Configure your `bitbucket-pipelines.yml` file to run your tests using your test runner of choice.

2. In Bitbucket, click **Settings** in the left hand nav bar.
3. Under **Pipelines**, click **Environment Variables**.
4. Add your `SAUCE_USERNAME` and `SAUCE_ACCESS_KEY` as environment variables. Now when you kick off a a build with Bitbucket Pipelines, your tests should run on Sauce Labs.
