

# Setting Up Sauce Labs and Bitbucket Pipelines

It's easy to launch your automated Selenium and Appium tests on Sauce Labs as part of your Bitbucket Pipelines build process.

## What You'll Need

- The SAUCE\_USERNAME and SAUCE\_ACCESS\_KEY [specific to your Sauce Labs account](#).
- [Sauce Labs account](#)
- [Bitbucket account](#)
- [Bitbucket Pipelines](#) installed on your Bitbucket account

## Procedure

1. Configure your `bitbucket-pipelines.yml` file to run your tests using your test runner of choice.

2. In Bitbucket, click **Settings** in the left hand nav bar.
3. Under **Pipelines**, click **Environment Variables**.
4. Add your `SAUCE_USERNAME` and `SAUCE_ACCESS_KEY` as environment variables. Now, when you kick off a build with Bitbucket Pipelines, your tests should run on Sauce Labs.
