

Setting Up CI Platform Integrations with Sauce Plugins

To make it easier to integrate testing in the Sauce Labs browser cloud with your continuous integration/continuous delivery platforms, Sauce Labs has developed plugins for several of the most popular platforms. These plugins have three key features:

1. They provides a user interface that lets you populate environment variables your CI/CD server that can be used in your tests (for example, platform configurations, or your [Sauce username and access key](#)). Much of what the plugins accomplish relates to the setting of environment variables.
 2. They automatically launch [Sauce Connect](#) when you enable it for a project.
 3. They handle reporting between your CI/CD platform and Sauce.
